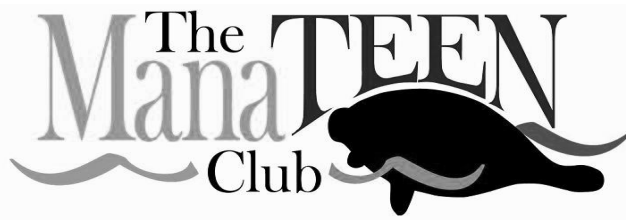

## Course/Training Descriptions

The Volunteer Reception Center (VRC) is activated following a disaster, and serves as the starting point for both volunteers and people or agencies needing volunteer assistance. The VRC connects individuals or groups desiring to help with the locations in need of assistance. The location depends on the area or areas affected by the disaster. A VRC is more of a concept than a location. This opportunity is a "simulation" of a VRC performed by ManaTEENs and the Volunteer Center of Manatee County to better prepare staff and volunteers. Volunteers needed to assist with roles and positions in this simulation.

**Everyone invited to participate!**

ManaTEEN First Aid, CPR, AED training complements a variety of learning styles with hands-on practice and real-life scenarios. Our take-away materials are designed for use both in the course and outside the classroom as reference tools. Combining lecture, video demonstrations and hands-on manikin training, this course teaches participants to: Call and work with EMS, Perform CPR and care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, Avoid blood borne pathogens exposure, know the role of automated external defibrillators (AEDs) in the Cardiac Chain of Survival and more!
